Lagois Photo Competition - Call for entries - Sustainable living

Climate justice concerns us all. We all know that we cannot treat our planet carelessly. But how can we lead a socially and environmentally responsible life? Protect the environment and manage resources sustainably? Only by changing something together in order to enable sustainable living conditions for inhabitants of the Global South and future generations.

The competition is worth EUR 5,000. We are looking for photo reports about people or groups who live climate justice. Small and big heroes, who are fearlessly committed to protecting the environment against global warming, taking responsibility and driving social change.

Is the future green and the ecology blue? How can we save our Earth? Will artificial intelligence help us do that?

We want to make the causes, consequences and options for action for climate justice visible – be it the cultivation of regional food, the expansion of urban green spaces or the production of sustainable products. Other topics include sustainable mobility, social justice, nature conservation, water, biodiversity and upcycling.

The photo competition comprises two categories and addresses both professional photographers as well as youngsters aged 14 to 27 years. Closing date for entries is 26th March 2023. Furthermore, we award a promotion prize for a project that is not yet realized or completed. Closing date for the promotion prize is January 15th 2023. The best photos will be presented in a traveling exhibition throughout Germany, and a book of photographs will additionally be published on the subject.

The Regional Bishop for Munich and Upper Bavaria, Christian Kopp, is the patron of the competition. Cooperation partners are the Bavarian Protestant Youth (ejb), Mission One World, Oikocredit Germany, the environmental department of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bavaria, the diakonia Bavaria, fair trade ConSozial and the printing house Pigture.

Lagois Photo Competition has been offered since 2008 by the Evangelischer Presseverband für Bayern e.V. (EPV), the Bavarian Protestant media association. The prize was named after priest Martin Lagois, who shaped Protestant media communication.

Lagois Photo Competition

Lagois Photo Competition on the subject of "sustainable living" is worth EUR 4,000. The photo prize for German photographers is awarded in two categories:

- 1. The photo prize in the amount of EUR 2,500 is directed at professional photographers.
- 2. The youth prize addresses youngsters and young adults aged 14 to 27 years. It is sponsored by the Evangelische Jugend in Bayern and the Stiftung Evangelische Jugendarbeit. Teamwork can be submitted. Anyone underage will have to enclose a declaration of consent from their parents.

Applicants can submit analogue and digital photo reports or series with a maximum of ten photographs, smartphone pictures and short videos (max. 60 seconds). The photos must have been taken within the last three years. All Photos are accepted unless parts were added or deleted (composing). A selection of the submitted photos will be presented in a travelling exhibition.

- short CV with contact details (email, website, telephone)
- 5-10 photographs,
- short description of the project
- people underage: declaration of consent from parents

Application deadline for Lagois Photo Competition is March 26th 2023.

Lagois promotion prize

The promotion prize is worth EUR 1,000. The promoted project about "sustainable living" needs to be finished by the end of May 2023. The promotion is directed at photographers who would like to realize, finish or expand a certain photographic project. The results will be presented at the award ceremony as an installation, analogue or digital exhibition.

To apply please hand in one PDF document size A4 including the following papers:

- exposé on the subject with a description of its aim and a representation of its method (max. one page size A4)
- CV with information on professional record as well as on publications, exhibitions and contact details (address, e-mail, website, phone number)
- 5-10 photographs as work samples.

Copyright:

The participants affirm that they have all rights to the submitted images, that the images are free of third party rights and that no personal rights are infringed in the depiction of persons. If one or more persons are clearly depicted on the photographs, the persons concerned must agree to the material being published. Participants will insure this on request. Should third parties nevertheless assert claims for infringement of their rights, the participants shall indemnify the organizers from all claims.

Granting of rights:

The contestants agree by submitting their application documents that their images may be used free of charge by the EPD for the following purposes: as part of the traveling exhibition to the competition, in the catalogue of exhibition, in educational accompanying material for the exhibition, in the cross-media coverage of the competition and the traveling exhibition (print, TV, online, Social Media). The EPV may also use works for press and public relations in the context of the competition and the exhibition. Legal recourse is out of the question.

Underage applicants:

The participation of minors and the publication of their contributions is only possible with the written consent of their legal guardians (see appendix). The EPV reserves the right to subsequently contact participants who have not yet reached the age of majority in order to obtain the consent of their legal guardians to assign the right of use. Successful acquisition of consent is a prerequisite for winning.

Data protection:

The data of the participants will be collected for the handling, execution and organization of the entire competition including call for entries, submission, jury, exhibition, award ceremony and subsequent events. We only transfer personal data to third parties if this is necessary in the context of contract processing, e. g. to the credit institution in charge of payment processing. A further transmission of the data does not take place, or only if you have expressly consented to the transfer. Your data will not be passed on to third parties, for example for advertising purposes, without your explicit consent. Participants have the right to receive information about the origin, recipient and purpose of their stored personal data at any time and free of charge. They also have the right to request the correction, blocking or deletion of this data.
